NOTE: The items below will be necessary if you plan to apply for Federal Financial Aid. You must also apply for PIN numbers at www.pin.ed.gov prior to attending. Please bring these numbers with you to MGCCC College Information Night.

- Driver's license and Social Security number of student
- W-2 forms and other records of income earned in 2009 (student and parents, or spouse if student is married)
- 2009 income tax return (student and parents, or spouse if student is married)
- If applicable, both parents' Social Security numbers and dates of birth.
- Record of untaxed income (Social Security benefits, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, Welfare, VA Benefits)
- Value of bank accounts (checking and savings accounts), investments, business and farm assets
